WE, THE UNDERSIGNED ARBITRATORS, having been designated in accordance with the Arbitration Agreement entered into by the above-named Parties, and having been duly sworn and having duly heard the proofs and allegations of the Parties, AWARD, as follows:


Kidder Peabody & Co. and Gregory F. Wilbur, jointly and severally hereinafter referred to as Respondents, shall pay to Edith Bridges, hereinafter referred to as Claimant, the total sum, including pre-Award interest and expert witness costs, of ONE HUNDRED ONE THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED FOURTEEN DOLLARS AND FORTY SIX CENTS (\$101,614.46).

The administrative fees of the American Arbitration Association totalling THREE THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED DOLLARS AND ZERO CENTS (\$3,400.00) shall be borne by Respondents. Therefore, Respondents shall pay to Claimant the sum of TWO THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS AND ZERO CENTS (\$2,200.00) for those fees previously advanced to the Association by Claimant.

The compensation and expenses of the arbitrators totalling NINE THOUSAND ONE HUNDRED FOUR DOLLARS AND THIRTY FIVE CENTS (\$9,104.35) shall be borne by Respondents. Therefore, Respondents shall pay to Claimant the sum of FOUR THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED FIFTY TWO DOLLARS AND EIGHTEEN CENTS (\$4,552.18) for that compensation previously advanced to the Association by Claimant.

The Tribunal does not find in favor of Claimant on any of her statutory claims. This Award is in full settlement of all claims submitted to this arbitration.
